



School Wide Educational Services Plan

Students excluded for more than 10 consecutive school days, whether in or out of school, are entitled to educational services so they have an opportunity to make academic progress during the period of exclusion, to make up assignments and earn credits missed, including but not limited to homework, quizzes, exams, papers and projects missed.

All students excluded for more than 10 days may access the school-wide education service plan which includes but is not limited to:

- After school assistance
- Alternative Placement
- Saturday School
- Tutoring
- Online Credit Recovery or Home Instruction
- Blue Hills Continuing Education Vocational Courses, if available

The principal shall notify the parent/guardian and student of the opportunity to receive education services at the time the student is expelled or placed on long-term suspension. Upon selection of appropriate education services, the school shall track and report student enrollment and participation.
